# CAK 101



- Public entity, governed by eight-member Board of Trustees
- Over \$1.01 billion in economic impact, 4,486 jobs, \$212 million in payroll; \$85 million in tax revenue
- We operate on the revenues generated on the airport; zero local tax dollars
- **Critical infrastructure; helping essential travelers connect in a safe environment**
- 2019 customers: 835,000

# Industry and CAK

- CAK is deemed essential infrastructure - we have remained open and operational during the pandemic.
- CAK has lost 85% of capacity in the month of May, looking at a similar impact in June.
- CAK is reporting only around 100 passengers through TSA per day.
- Incurring costs while not generating revenue, likely to lost \$1.8 million by August 2020.
- Using CARES act funding for payroll and debt services during this critical time; saving portion for long-term impact.

**U.S. airports are projected to lose \$23 billion during this pandemic.**

**IATA projects a \$252 billion loss globally for airlines.**

# Air Service Impact

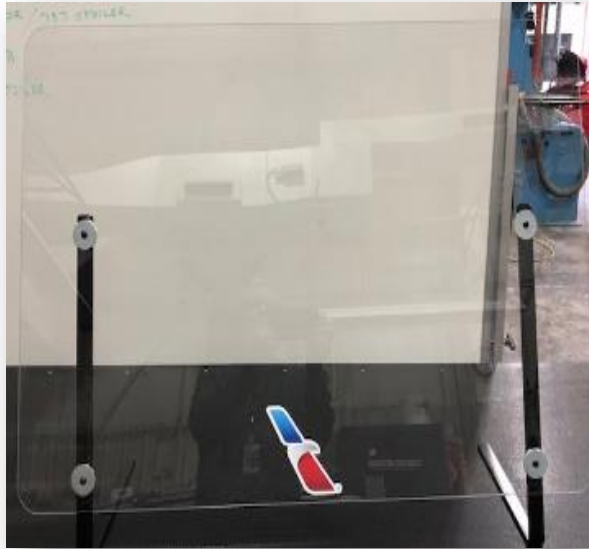
## All routes impacted

- Frequency cut across all operational routes
  - Seasonal routes ended early
- Service suspension until June for: LGA, DCA, MCO, ORD (American only)
- Service suspension until September for: IAH and IAD
- Airlines have not exercised consolidation of airports at this time


