## 1 Parent is Required to Attend

Student attendance is optional.



## Create FSA ID's

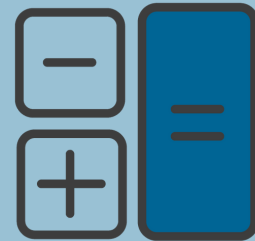
An FSA ID is required for both the parent and the student and must be created at [fsaid.ed.gov](https://fsaid.ed.gov) prior to your appointment.

Please have a list of schools that the student wants to apply to.



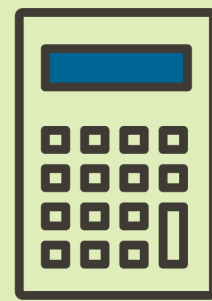
## 2019 Tax Returns for Student & Parent

Entire 2019 Federal Tax Return for both the parent(s) and student as well as your 2019 W-2's.



## Parent's Date of Marriage or Divorce

Parent's date of marriage. If divorced, date of divorce. Month and year only.



## Know Amounts in Accounts

- How much is in the parent & student checking and savings accounts.
- Total value of investments (stocks, bonds, 529 Plan, mutual funds, CD's, NOT retirement).

## If Applicable....

- Annual amounts of untaxed income received in the household (SSDI or child support)
- Resident card number
- If you own a business that employs more than 100 people, please know the total value of the business (buildings & equipment) and how much you owe on the business
