In-House Certified Passive House Designer (CPHD) Training



The CPHD course is the premier core Passive House professional training, providing the Certified Passive House Designer or Consultant credential, depending on individual qualifications, upon successful completion of the exam.

In-house training provides dedicated and personal training - providing Passive House team building in your organization.

The CPHD course, when offered in-person, is typically provided in a block of five 8-hour days, with the outline of subjects as follows:

- **Day 1:** Introduction to Passive House principles, with an in-depth look at enclosure insulation & thermal bridging: principles, calculations, details, systems and components.
- **Day 2:** Enclosure airtightness and windows: principles, calculations, details, systems and components.
- **Day 3:** Ventilation, heating, cooling, dehumidification and domestic hot water: principles, calculations, details, systems and components.
- Day 4: PHPP energy model and calculating building energy balance.
- Day 5: Retrofits, economics, certifications and exam preparation.

The greatest scheduling flexibility is possible when a dedicated in-house course is conducted online.

Also included with the course are the following:

- Course manual (pdf download)
- PHPP software in IP units and hardcopy PHPP reference manual
- · Reference sheets
- Supplemental online learning resources
- Exam prep and examination

The exam date is scheduled for the students at registration and often occurs a number of weeks after the course to allow for further review and study. The exam is only offered remotely online.
