




HOW I BELONG • BEGINNER

Students will examine the art of Christian Robinson with a focus on belonging. Students will create an artwork about a place of personal significance where they feel they belong. Students will include contextual information and subject matter in their work of art.



MY AMERICA • INTERMEDIATE

Students will examine the work of Gordon Parks and his use of symbolism of American society through the lens of multiple populations. Students will create a mixed-media artwork symbolizing personally relevant content and perception of America through their own lens.



OUR TRUTH MAGAZINE • ADVANCED

Students will study Kadir Nelson's visual narratives that show the experiences of Black Americans. Students will create paintings of a magazine cover telling visual narratives of their life stories past and present, revealing their lives' truths.






