

A TIMELINE OF THE

PPP

The **Paycheck Protection Program** is a signature of the historic U.S. government emergency response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

H.R. 6201

On March 18, 2020, The **Families First Coronavirus Response Act** was enacted. It provided \$104 billion for expanded paid medical and family leave due to COVID-19.

H.R. 266

On April 24, 2020, The **Paycheck Protection and Healthcare Enhancement Act** added \$484 billion to PPP.

H.R. 6074

On March 6, 2020, The **Coronavirus Preparedness and Response Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2020** was signed into law. It allocated **\$8.3 billion** for vaccine R&D.

H.B. 748

On March 27, 2020, The **Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act** became law.

The law's historic \$2.2 trillion bill allocated \$349 billion to the PPP.

H.R. 7010

The **Paycheck Protection Program Flexibility Act** modified PPP loan forgiveness was signed into law on June 5, 2020.

H.R. 133

Enacted on December 27, 2020, The **Consolidated Appropriations Act** reopened the PPP
