



RESIDENCE HALL COVID-19 SAFETY GUIDELINES

The following procedures have been put in place to provide a safe environment for students and staff in the International School of Minnesota Residence Hall.

- Custodians spray the entire building. They use the electromagnetic static, hospital-grade sanitizer spray.
- Dorm supervisor spray every day as needed (bedrooms, common areas, gym, etc).
- Supervisors check each student's temperature before students goes to school and upon arrival at the dorm.
- Dorm student meetings held once a week. Students wear mask and keep a distance.
- A strict separation of each student to reduce cross contamination and the spread of germs.
- Frequent washing of hands and the use of hand sanitizer is advised daily.
- Supervisors ensure all students wash hands before and after each meal and wipe down their table with disinfectant wipes.
- All unnecessary guests and visitors have been postponed until further notice.
- Mandatory masks worn by residence hall students and supervisors (except when students are in their own rooms)
- Off campus activities have been postponed until further notice.
