In May, Omnilert introduced fast, reliable, and actionable <u>weather alerts</u> through a native integration with our award-winning emergency mass notification platform. The user-friendly setup enables administrators to quickly review notifications and initiate automated pre-defined workflows depending on the situation.

Organizations of any size can monitor a limitless number of locations and filter the weather alerts based on severity. Recipients can be segmented into groups to receive notifications via SMS text message and mobile app push notifications specific to their region. Weather alerts are sent through Omnilert's <u>Instant App</u>, which provides the complete mobile safety app experience to users without requiring them to download or install anything.

As demand increased from customers outside of higher education, the Amerilert brand was added under the corporate umbrella.
