It starts off with the Preparatory Year (AP), an intensive semester of hospitality training in Lausanne that includes 20+ workshops covering a wide variety of Food & Beverage styles, a Michelin-starred restaurant experience and rooms division departments, followed by an internship in the real-world of hospitality.

Delivered in Lausanne and Singapore, the three-year degree portion builds your global business competencies with a challenging academic approach to management theory. The first year gives you a deep understanding of hospitality operations, the second year elevates your knowledge with applied management theory and the third year requires you to integrate all you've learned to conduct business consulting projects and choose career-focused electives.
