LOCATION CERTAINTY

The importance of location certainty is **CRITICAL** when selecting a Staff Safety & Duress system.

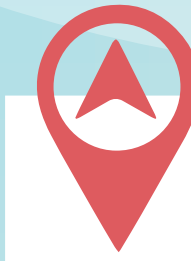
WHY? Because when staff needs assistance, you need to be able to find them. **QUICKLY!**

Location certainty pinpoints their exact location at room level, not floor level.



FLOOR LEVEL

provides a **general location** of a person in an area or unit.



ROOM LEVEL

provides the ability to pinpoint a staff's location **to a specific room or space**.
Time is of the essence and knowing where they are is critical.

REPORT FREQUENCY

Does the staff's badge talk to the duress system at a speed that promptly alerts you that staff needs assistance?

More importantly does it continue to report every 6 seconds until the threat is discontinued by the system admin?

VISIBILITY

Does technology flood the room with a signal? So, that no matter the situation, like when a staff member is grabbed from behind and dragged into a closet, their badge is still signaling and communicating their location.
