



The new [MetroED Health Screening](#) is now available for daily use. Please [watch this short video](#) or [view these slides](#) on how to use the web version. It is extremely important that health screening takes place daily, at home, before students or staff board the school bus and enter buildings.



Each day, everyone will answer a series of prompts to determine if they are COVID-19 symptom-free. A green checkmark will indicate approval to proceed to school or work. A red box means to stay home, do automatically be notified once the daily screening has been completed.

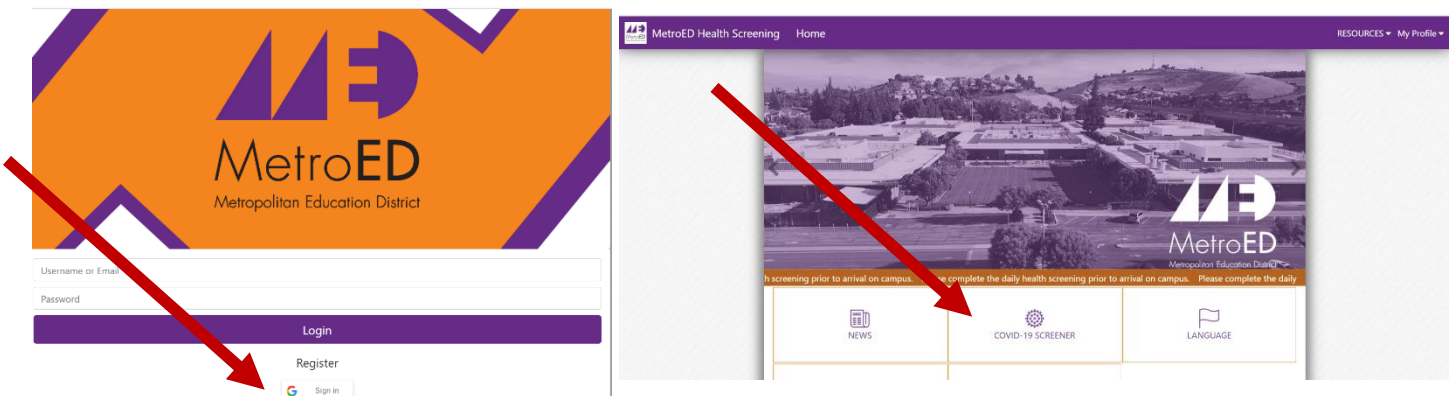


Students are to show their digital pass (green check) to their bus driver and teacher before they are allowed to enter. Please have the screen pulled up on your phone, questions completed, and ready to show the green check with the current date displayed.

Instructions to use the web version

1. Using a smartphone go to: <http://siap.ps/f41dce>
2. Click allow notifications
3. Click the Google  Sign in (*at the very bottom of the page*)
No registration or password is needed
4. **Students MUST** use their **mymetroed.net** emails
5. **Staff MUST** use their **metroed.net** emails
6. Refresh your screen if you do not see the Google  Sign in at the bottom
7. Click on the COVID-19 SCREENER and answer the prompts
