COVID-19 HEALTH & SAFTEY PROTOCOLS

Weekly COVID-19 Saliva Surveillance Program

Bennett Day campers and counselors will have access to weekly COVID-19 saliva surveillance through our partnership with Safeguard Surveillance.

Negative PCR Test Required to Participate

All campers will be required to submit a negative COVID-19 PCR (polymerase chain reaction) test before their first day of camp.

Employee Vaccinations

All Bennett Day counselors and on-campus staff members have received the COVID-19 vaccine.

On-Site Medical Experts

Bennett Day has a full-time, on-campus Nurse throughout the school year and summer.

Stable Groups

Camper groups are created based on age and number of weeks attending to create as stable groups as possible. Make sure to let us know any friend requests when registering!

Mask Wearing

Bennett Day campers and counselors wear masks while on campus. During lunch and nap periods, campers and counselors are set up to appropriately social distance.

Cleaning

From outdoor hand washing stations to special MyShield protective sprays on all equipment, Bennett has taken every measure possible to keep our campers safe.

HVAC/Outdoor Time

Bennett Day's most recent expansion was completed in the Fall of 2019. Our campus includes a state-of-the-art fresh air HVAC system as well as six outdoor learning and playing centers.

Expert Input

All safety protocols are designed and implemented by our Community Health Response Team (CHRT) which is composed of Bennett leadership, CDC advisors, and Medical Staff. The CHRT team is well versed in IDPH, CDPH, and CDC guidance and ensures our community is informed and following to the most up to date recommendations.

100% Refund Policy

Camp fees are processed on the first day your camper arrives at camp. If your camper does not attend camp due to COVID-related circumstances, they will not be charged for camp.

BENNETT DAY CAMP

4 Y/O-5th Grade | Full Day 9:00 am - 3:00 pm | \$525 Weekly June 28 - August 6

Bennett Day Camp is back with our best day camp yet! This summer campers will participate in group games, unique art projects, and STEM challenges all tied to our weekly theme. Each camper contributes to the design of their day with flexible afternoon activities that can include drone racing, sewing and textiles, claymation, digital photography, slime time, coding, mechanical engineering, basketball, soccer, flag football, handball, and badminton! On Water Wednesdays campers beat the heat with water relays, balloon tosses, and more fun. CAMP T.E.S. (TECHNOLOGY AND ENGINEERING SCIENCES)

6th-10th grade | Full Day 9:00 am - 3:00 pm | \$525 June 28 - July 2, July 5 - July 9

Rising 6th-10th grade campers will explore elements of design, material sciences, and engineering in this week-long exploration into creating with purpose. Campers will face real-world challenges and develop innovative prototypes that positively impact our community. Design projects for this camp include creating a custom batterypowered ride-on car for children with limited mobility and solutions for real world challenges determined by participants. Campers can sign up for one or both weeks of the camp. Afternoons will be spent outdoors in explorations of our garden, drone racetrack, athletic facilities, and our surrounding community.

WOODWORKING

6th-10th grade | Full Day 9:00 am - 3:00 pm | \$600** July 12 - July 16, July 19 - July 23

This woodworking class teaches how to safely use real (age appropriate) tools to design and build with reclaimed materials. Beginner campers will make projects such as coasters, boxes with secret compartments, benches, and mirrors. Campers with experience will make serving trays, side tables, plant stands, and their own designs. Camp will be led by industry professionals from the Rebuilding Exchange and other local woodworkers. **All materials and tools for the camps are included in the price.

TECH & ENTREPRENEURSHIP

6th-10th grade | Full Day 9:00 am - 3:00 pm | \$525 July 26 - July 30

In this week-long collaboration with VineyardAppCamp, a silicon valley technology company, campers will spend their mornings developing the skills to be a coder and the mindset to be an entrepreneur, through actually building and releasing an iPhone app with their peers! The week begins with logic and coding development before having campers develop an app for a real, local non-profit organization. Afternoons will be spent outdoors in explorations of our garden, drone racetrack, athletic facilities, and our surrounding community.

DESIGN ENTREPRENEURSHIP

6th-10th grade | Full Day 9:00 am - 3:00 pm | \$525 Aug. 2nd - Aug. 6

In week two of our collaboration with VineyardAppCamp, campers will spend their mornings focused on the basics of modern digital design on web platforms, including Canva, Pixlr, and Adobe. They will learn design elements such as colors, contrast, composition, and digital typography. Then, at the end of the course, they will collaborate to create a professional design project for a local nonprofit that will be used in a campaign launched at the end of the week. Afternoons will be spent outdoors in explorations of our garden, drone racetrack, athletic facilities, and our surrounding community.

COUNSELOR IN LEADERSHIP TRAINING PROGRAM

11-12th grade | 9:00 am - 12:00 pm | \$100 | June 28 - Aug. 6 Rising 11th/12th grade students can attend this counselor education program to receive hands-on experience in childcare. By the end of the week campers will receive a CPR and 1st aid certification, further develop their decision-making and problem-solving skills, and be confident in their ability to provide short term childcare.



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
