

Demand Flex | ENGIE Seasonal Program – ERCOT

A Custom Economic Program to Realize
Revenue on Untapped Market Opportunities



Capitalize on low reserve margins and hot summer temperatures by participating in the ENGIE Seasonal Program – ERCOT. Create immediate and long-term economic value with simplified curtailment plans built to specific operational requirements and capabilities, including manual and automated controls.

Enrollment ensures a one-time, upfront payment for block quantities committed to the program, covering four-hour curtailment events spread over 10 days from June 1 through Sept. 30. Customers may choose to subscribe to a minimum of six events. Unlike ERCOT or utility-based programs, the ENGIE Seasonal Program – ERCOT features a preset curtailment window of 2 to 6 p.m. with day-ahead notifications as well as two-hour reminders sent in advance of events.

ENGIE designates the days on which the events are called and will call no more than 10 events during a four-month summer season. Physical curtailment is not mandatory. However, committed volumes that are not curtailed will be settled at real-time prices.

WHO can benefit?

- Customers who can curtail load for four-hour events either manually or through automated controls
- Customers under a block and index contract structure
- Customers who have a minimum curtailable demand of 500kW during June, July, August, and September
