HIGH MODULUS

Features

- Hard wearing
- Low stretch

Applications

- Sealing baths, sinks and internal applications.
- Glass to glass joints
- Shop fronts

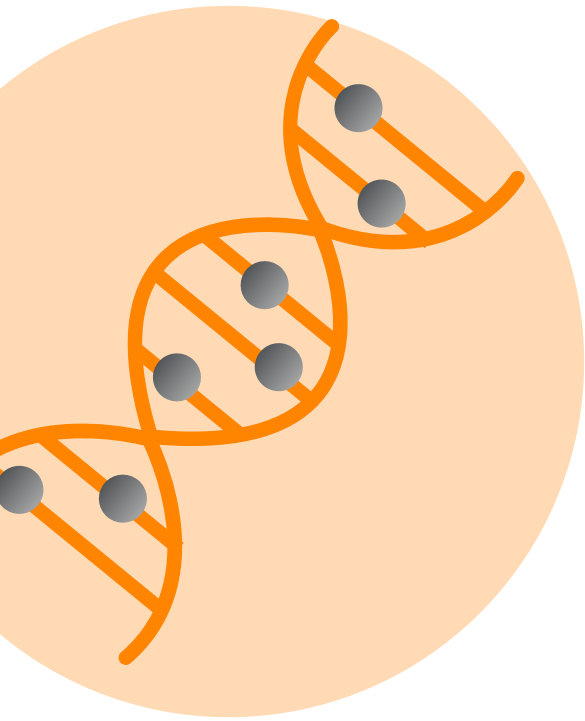
LOW MODULUS

Features

- Higher stretch
- Excellent adhesion
- Accommodate more movement
- Long lasting

Applications

- Perimeter seals
- Glass wall assemblies



ACETOXY CURE

Advantages

- Faster cure time
- More rigid than neutral cure
- Better on non-porous surfaces

Disadvantages

- Strong vinegar smell during curing
- Poor adhesion to uPVC, plastics, glass and aluminium

NEUTRAL CURE

Advantages

- No smell
- Excellent adhesion to a wide range of substrates
- Ideal for metal and plastic applications

Disadvantages

- Longer cure times
- Generally more expensive
