HUD Updates HHS/CDC COVID-19 FAQs and Supplemental PIH FAQs

Last week on the [Public and Indian Housing COVID-19 Resources](#) webpage, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) posted an updated version of the frequently asked questions (FAQs) from the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) regarding the [order](#) under Section 361 of the Public Health Service Act to temporarily halt residential evictions to prevent the further spread of COVID-19. As you recall, the CDC eviction moratorium was published September 4, 2020. The updated document is dated January 5, 2021.

HUD has also updated the [supplemental set of FAQs](#) regarding the CDC order as it relates to HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing (PIH) programs. Updated questions are flagged as such in this new version, dated January 8, 2021.

HUD Publishes FY 2020 Section 202 NOFA

Yesterday on [Grants.gov](#), HUD [published](#) the Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for the FY 2020 [Section 202](#) Supportive Housing for the Elderly program. The program provides capital advance funding for the development and operation of supportive rental housing for very low-income persons 62 and older and project rental assistance contract (PRAC) subsidies to maintain ongoing affordability. The idea is to provide very low-income elderly persons the opportunity to live independently with voluntary support services. Funding of up to \$150 million is available through this NOFA.
