HUD Publishes Radon Testing and Mitigation Demonstration NOFA

Yesterday on [grants.gov](#), the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) [posted](#) the notice of funding availability ([NOFA](#)) for its Radon Testing and Mitigation Demonstration program for public housing. The NOFA makes approximately \$4,000,000 in grants to public housing agencies to conduct testing and, when needed, mitigation of radon in the units that they manage. The work supported through this NOFA will also provide HUD with important information on methods and costs for radon testing and mitigation in public housing. The application deadline date is **March 28, 2022**. HUD also announced the NOFA in a [press release](#) issued today.



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
