HUD to Host Webinar Series on How to Update ACOP

On the [HUD Exchange News webpage](#), the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) [announced](#) that it will be hosting a webinar series to provide PHAs with tips on how to develop, revise, and implement their agency’s admissions and continued occupancy policy (ACOP) in accordance with current HUD requirements.

The first session in the series is scheduled for February 16, 2022, from 1:30–3:30 p.m. Eastern Time, and it will focus on the following five chapters from the updated [Public Housing Occupancy Guidebook](#):

- Lease Requirements
- Community Service and Self-Sufficiency Requirement
- Transfers
- Pet Ownership
- Grievance Procedures

The webinar will provide participants with best practices and sample approaches that they can use to formulate their internal policies and update their ACOP. It will also introduce additional resources and materials that are available on the [HUD Exchange](#), including the ACOP Development Guide and short, topical policy fact sheets. As such, the webinar is intended for PHA staff and board members, as well as industry representatives who work with PHAs and have an interest in public housing program requirements.
