HUD Awards \$36 Million in Capacity Building Grants

In a [press release](#) yesterday, the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) announced that it has awarded \$36 million in funding for community development and affordable housing activities. According to the announcement, the funds will support three national organizations and are ultimately expected to produce approximately 8,000 units of affordable housing nationwide and stimulate nearly \$150 million in total investment. The following organizations will receive funds: Enterprise Community Partners, Local Initiatives Support Corporation (LISC), and Habitat for Humanity International.
