HUD Updates CDC COVID-19 FAQs, Posts Tenant Flyer

Yesterday on the [Public and Indian Housing COVID-19 Resources](#) webpage, the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) posted an updated version of the frequently asked questions ([FAQs](#)) regarding the [order](#) issued by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention ([CDC](#)) to temporarily halt residential evictions to prevent the further spread of COVID-19. As you recall, the CDC eviction moratorium was published on September 4, 2020. The updated FAQs, dated November 18, 2020, are related to HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing ([PIH](#)) programs. Updated and new questions are flagged as such in this new version.

HUD has also posted a [Tenant Flyer](#) that helps to understand what the CDC order means for HUD-assisted tenants who are renters in the following PIH programs: Housing Choice Voucher ([HCV](#)) program, Public Housing program, and Section 8 Moderate Rehabilitation ([Mod Rehab](#)) program.
