HUD Extends Application Due Date for the HCV Mobility Demonstration

Today in the *Federal Register*, the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) published a [notice](#) announcing that it has further extended the application due date for the HCV Mobility Demonstration, this time to **February 1, 2021**. According to the notice, "HUD is extending the submission deadline date while HUD considers, in response to questions HUD has received from PHAs, whether and to what extent PHAs may participate in both the Mobility Demonstration program and the Moving to Work ([MTW](#)) Expansion program." HUD anticipates publishing another notice to address this question.

As you recall, HUD published the original Mobility Demonstration implementation [notice](#) on July 15. The notice defined PHA eligibility criteria, established the application process and factors HUD will employ in rating and ranking PHA applications, and explained the special rules and requirements applicable to PHAs selected for participation in the demonstration, in addition to identifying the specific waivers and alternative requirements established by the Secretary for the demonstration.
