HUD Announces Removal of Obsolete Guidance Documents

Yesterday in the *Federal Register*, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) published another [notice](#) announcing the removal of obsolete and superseded guidance documents from HUD's program websites. As you recall, HUD released a similar [announcement](#) back in April 2019. Per yesterday's notice, the department is removing certain guidance documents that have been deemed unnecessary and obsolete after having completed a second review of all administrative guidance. According to the notice, removal of such documentation will reduce compliance burdens and promote regulatory analysis, fair notice, and administrative due process. It will also make it easier for HUD constituents and members of the public to determine the guidance that currently applies.

Appendix A of the [notice](#) lists Public and Indian Housing (PIH) notices that are being removed from HUD websites, and Appendix B covers other PIH guidance. While items slated for removal in both appendices are too extensive to list here, they do not appear to include anything earth-shattering. HUD has stated that it does intend to archive some of the former guidance for historical and research purposes, and that the archive will be clearly marked to avoid confusion.
