# **HUD Awards Second Round of Lead Hazard Grants**

In a <u>press release</u> today, HUD announced the recipients of nearly \$13.2 million to protect children and families from lead-based paint and home health hazards. Grants were awarded to three local and state government agencies under the Lead Based Paint Hazard Reduction Program.

The grants announced today are the second round of grants this year from the Lead Based Paint Hazard Reduction Program. A state-by-state list of recipients is included in the press release.

# **HUD Awards Additional Foster Youth to Independence Initiative Funding**

In another <u>press release</u> today, HUD announced that it has awarded over \$1 million to 26 PHAs across the nation in the latest installation of grants to assist young people aging out of foster care and who are at risk of experiencing homelessness. The funding, awarded under HUD's Foster Youth to Independence (<u>FYI</u>) Initiative, will offer housing vouchers to local PHAs to prevent or end homelessness among young adults under the age of 25 who are leaving, or have recently left, the foster care system. Funding is provided in the form of tenant protection vouchers (TPVs) to certain PHAs that do not participate in HUD's Family Unification Program (<u>FUP</u>). HUD had previously awarded over \$14 million to 18 PHAs in September of this year. A complete list of awardees and the amounts they will receive can be found in the <u>press release</u>.
