PIH Posts Op Sub Obligation Letters for January and February

HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing (PIH) has <u>posted</u> the public housing operating subsidy obligation letters for January and February. As usual, the letters to all PHAs in the same state are combined in a single file, which you can access through the map on <u>this webpage</u>. You'll find links to the obligation letters on the <u>2022 operating fund grant processing page</u> at the <u>operating fund website</u>.

PIH Announces UEL Inflation Factor

On the <u>2022 operating fund grant processing page</u>, PIH has posted a <u>PDF document</u> announcing that the inflation factor to be used in the HUD-52722 tools for calculating calendar year (CY) 2022 utility expense levels (UELs) is **1.0313**. The document also explains how PIH calculated the inflation factor. The calculation involves determining the weighted rate of change in utility costs during the reporting period (2.08 percent) and then inflating it to the anticipated rate that PHAs will pay during the funding period (3.13 percent).

Last week on the <u>HCV Landlord Resources</u> webpage, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (<u>HUD</u>) added the <u>recording</u> and <u>presentation materials</u> for the "Landlord-Focused Customer Service" webinar that was held on November 4, 2021.

The webinar walked through the latest published chapter of the <u>HCV Landlord Strategy</u> <u>Guidebook</u>, which focuses on ways that PHAs can improve their HCV program and landlord satisfaction by intentionally focusing on landlord customer service.

HUD Announces Latest in ConnectHome Webinar Series
