HUD Proposes Information Collection on Executive Compensation Reporting

Last Friday in the *Federal Register*, the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) published a [30-Day Notice of Proposed Information Collection](#) titled "Public Housing Agency Executive Compensation Information." The purpose of the notice is to allow for an additional 30 days of public comment. According to the document, HUD would change the reporting requirements for public housing agency executive compensation information from annually to once every three years. However, PHAs are still subject to the annual compensation restrictions imposed by Congress. Therefore, all years remain subject to potential review by HUD to ensure compliance with the Annual Appropriations Act. The new due date for comments is **March 14, 2022**.
