HUD Releases Updated HUD-VASH Site List

The Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) has posted an [updated state-by-state listing](#) of sites receiving funding under the HUD–Veterans Affairs ([VA](#)) supportive housing ([HUD-VASH](#)) program. The spreadsheet, which is available as a [PDF](#) file, shows HUD-VASH vouchers awarded since the program's inception in 2008, including the funding for fiscal year (FY) 2020.

In the HUD-VASH program, VA Medical Centers (VAMCs) assess veterans experiencing homelessness before referring them to local housing agencies for these vouchers. HUD-VASH vouchers enable homeless veterans to obtain affordable and decent housing in the private market. Veterans rent privately owned housing and generally contribute no more than 30 percent of their income toward rent. Since 2008, more than 100,000 vouchers have been awarded through the program.



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
