HUD to Host Virtual Symposium for California Landlords

Yesterday on the [HCV Landlord Resources](#) webpage, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) announced that it will be hosting a three-day virtual symposium for California landlords. HUD Announces Moving On Webinar Series

HUD also [announced](#) that it will be hosting a webinar series titled “Moving On – Spring 2021.” The series of seven webinars will introduce participants to the tools and resources they need to develop and implement Moving On strategies and programs that help tenants who wish to move on from supportive housing.

As stated on the [Moving On](#) webpage, as part of its strategic priority to end homelessness, HUD encourages communities to explore Moving On strategies for clients in permanent supportive housing (PSH) who may no longer need or want the intensive services offered but continue to need rental assistance to maintain their housing.

Moving On strategies rely on partnerships between the Continuum of Care (CoC), PSH providers, including Housing Opportunities for Persons With AIDS (HOPWA) providers, and mainstream housing programs, such as public housing, the Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) program, and HUD-funded multifamily housing providers. As such, the training series is intended primarily for CoCs, PSH providers, HOPWA providers, and PHAs. Topics and webinar dates include the following:
