Nominations Open for Secretary's Historic Preservation Award

HUD's Office of Policy Development and Research ([PD&R](#)) has announced the opening of nominations for the [2021 HUD Secretary's Award for Excellence in Historic Preservation](#). The annual award is presented jointly by [HUD](#) and the Advisory Council for Historic Preservation ([ACHP](#)) to recognize developers, organizations, and agencies for their success in advancing the goals of historic preservation while providing affordable housing and expanded economic opportunities for low and moderate-income families and individuals.

Nominated projects or activities will be judged for the success they have achieved in preserving, rehabilitating, restoring, and interpreting our architectural and cultural heritage. Eligible projects must meet the following criteria:

- Promote the use of historic buildings for affordable housing, community development, and/or expanded economic opportunities
- Include HUD funds or financing
- Meet preservation guidelines
- Contribute to local and/or tribal community revitalization efforts
