REAC Issues Letter to EDs on FDS Reporting

Yesterday HUD's Real Estate Assessment Center ([REAC](#)) issued a [letter](#) to executive directors providing advance notification of an extension of the audited financial information submission deadlines for PHAs with certain fiscal year end (FYE). As the letter notes, HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing ([PIH](#)) will be issuing a notice shortly to update the guidance on the schedule for FDS reporting.

To allow PHAs sufficient time to plan, the letter notifies in advance that HUD has extended the audited submission deadline for all PHAs with a FYE of June 30, 2020 and September 30, 2020 by three months, making the new due dates **June 30, 2021** and **September 30, 2021**, respectively. As described in PIH Notices [2020-13](#) and [2020-33](#), HUD previously extended the audited submission deadline for PHAs with a March 31, 2020 FYE to **June 30, 2021** (six-month extension).

In the second page of the letter, you can find a table that shows the new deadline to submit audited financial information based on a PHA's FYE.

PIH Posts Detailed Calculation Reports for March and April

HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing ([PIH](#)) has posted detailed calculation reports for operating subsidy obligations for March and April. The calculations are presented in the same format as obligation letters—the calculations are organized with all PHAs in the same state combined in a single file, which you can access through a map [here](#). The explanation and letters for March and April obligations were posted in February.

HUD Announces NOFA for 2020 Capacity Building Grants

Yesterday the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) [announced](#) at [Grants.gov](#) a notice of funding availability ([NOFA](#)) for the fiscal year (FY) 2020 Capacity Building for Community Development and Affordable Housing Grants. The NOFA will make available \$36 million in funding for community development and affordable housing activities. The competition is limited to three organizations:
