HUD Extends SF-425 Submission Deadline for CARES Act Funds

HUD's PIH Office has revised Notice [PIH 2021-36](#), extending the SF-425 submission deadline for CARES Act funds. As you recall, the original notice required PHAs to submit an SF-425 for each CARES Act grant via the Operating Fund Web Portal by April 30, 2022, to report on the status of CARES Act Supplemental Operating Subsidy as of December 31, 2021. The SF-425 is now due on May 31, 2022, to allow sufficient time to complete the web-based submission portal. Complete details can be found in Section 5 of the [notice](#).

HUD Announces NOFO to Help Youth Experiencing Homelessness

In a [press release](#) today, the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) announced that it is making \$72 million available to up to 25 communities under the Youth Homelessness Demonstration Program ([YHDP](#)), an initiative designed to reduce the number of youth experiencing homelessness.

YHDP supports a wide range of housing programs, including rapid rehousing, permanent supportive housing, transitional housing, and host homes. Once selected, communities will collaborate with a broad array of partners including a youth advisory board and the local or state public child welfare agency to create a comprehensive community plan to end youth homelessness.
