HUD Publishes 2021 ROSS-SC NOFA

Yesterday on [grants.gov](https://www.grants.gov), HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing (PIH) published the federal fiscal year (FFY) 2021 notice of funding availability (NOFA) for the Resident Opportunity and Self-Sufficiency (ROSS) service coordinator (ROSS-SC) program. The NOFA makes approximately \$35,000,000 available for the provision of service coordinators for supportive services and other activities designed to help public housing residents attain economic and housing self-sufficiency. NLIHC Publishes Out of Reach 2021

The National Low-Income Housing Coalition (NLIHC) has published [Out of Reach 2021](#), a report on wages and rents throughout the country. In an accompanying [press release](#), NLIHC described this year's report as follows:

NLIHC's 'Out of Reach 2021' report concludes that millions of low-wage renters were struggling to afford their homes before the pandemic and will remain in an economically precarious position without significant congressional action. The report highlights the mismatch between the wages people earn and the price of decent rental housing in every state, metropolitan area, and county in the U.S.
