HUD Extends Deadline to Apply for FSS NOFA, Makes Technical Corrections

HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing ([PIH](#)) has extended the application deadline date for the 2021 notice of funding availability ([NOFA](#)) for both the Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) and the public housing Family Self-Sufficiency ([FSS](#)) programs to **September 7, 2021**. HUD has also made some technical corrections to the NOFA, which can be found on [this page](#) at HUD's [Funding Opportunities](#) website.

Under the combined NOFA, approximately \$105 million in renewal funding is available for FSS coordinator salaries to recipients of 2018, 2019, or 2020 FSS grants, or for those who received an FSS program through transfer or consolidation from a PHA funded under such NOFAs.
