HUD Publishes 2021 CoC Program NOFA

In a [press release](#) yesterday, and also [here](#), on [Grants.gov](#), the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) announced that it has published the notice of funding availability ([NOFA](#)) for fiscal year (FY) 2021 Continuum of Care (CoC) program competition. The NOFA makes available \$2.656 billion in funding for FY 2021 grants, including approximately \$77 million for noncompetitive Youth Homelessness Demonstration Program (YHDP) renewal and replacement expiring grants and up to \$102 million for new rapid re-housing, supportive services and other activities critical to assist survivors of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking. Applications must be completed and submitted in [e-snaps](#) by **November 16, 2021**.
