### **REAC Posts Get NSPIREd Newsletter**

The Real Estate Assessment Center (<u>REAC</u>) has <u>posted</u> the most recent issue of its newsletter on the National Standards for the Physical Inspection of Real Estate (<u>NSPIRE</u>), *Get NSPIREd*. The new issue, dated August 2020, provides updates regarding the following topics, among others:

As you know, the NSPIRE <u>demonstration</u> was announced last year to overhaul HUD's inspection process and test new approaches for making certain PHAs and owners provide housing that is safe and livable. NSPIRE will eventually be implemented as a single inspection protocol for public housing and HCV units.

# **HUD Announces Post Conversion Guide Webcast and Choice Mobility Guidance**

Today via RADBlast!, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (<u>HUD</u>) announced that HUD's Multifamily Office of Recapitalization will host a webinar providing an overview of the new <u>Post Conversion Approval Processing Guide</u>. The guide provides information to owners and PHAs on how to process issues that may arise after RAD conversion, and where to direct requests and inquiries. HUD also announced in today's RADBlast! that the Poverty and Race Research Action Council (PRRAC) has published a <u>Guide for Successful Implementation of RAD Choice-Mobility</u>. The new publication highlights recommended practices for PHAs and project owners of converted public housing properties on the effective implementation of the Choice-Mobility option, which provides residents with an option to obtain a voucher after a defined period.
