HUD Issues NOFA for Comprehensive Housing Counseling Grants

Yesterday on [Grants.gov](#), the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) [posted](#) the notice of funding availability (NOFA) for its [Housing Counseling Grant Program](#) for fiscal year (FY) 2021. The NOFA makes available \$51 million in grants to support housing counseling organizations in assisting consumers on seeking, financing, maintaining, renting, or owning a home. The program also addresses homelessness through counseling and assists homeowners in need of foreclosure assistance. The application deadline date is **October 14, 2021**.

The National Housing Law Project (NHLP) has [posted](#) the most recent edition of its series of newsletters, which are intended to address a variety of current housing issues that affect survivors of domestic and sexual violence.

The [Issue One 2021 Newsletter](#) features two articles regarding the housing needs of survivors during COVID-19. The first article provides a Q&A for advocates about how survivors can access COVID-19 rental assistance and includes a description of the types of expenses covered by rental assistance. The second article outlines the basics of the HUD's Emergency Housing Voucher (EHV) program, which provides a housing subsidy for certain populations, including survivors of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking, and human trafficking.
