User interface/experience (number of clicks, ease of use, intuitive)	Support (responsive vendor, there when we need them)
Single platform (manage employee health on one platform vs. mix of solutions)	Single sign-on (users/employees logged on from corporate environment)
Interoperability (interfaces w/HR system, labs, medical devices, etc.)	Accessibility (data easily accessed, can be aggregated across enterprise)
Employee portal/self service (employee self-scheduling, questionnaire completion)	Reporting (powerful reporting, ad-hoc reports, graphical reporting tools)
Confident compliance (reports and forms managed and completed automatically)	Reminders/alerts (automatic/electronic reminders, built-in alerts/warnings)
Clinic productivity/efficiency (limited manual effort, employee self-service, automation)	Data entry (data entered once, propagates across solution)

Health surveillance (automated management of surveillance requirements)	Immunizations (manages individual and mass immunizations)
Clinical care (handles non-occ, primary care, disease management)	Scheduling (integrated scheduling, employee self-scheduling)
Worksite injury & illness (robust data capture, case management)	Document management (manages paper documents, incorporates existing forms)
Work status (generates/electronically delivers work status reports)	External provider management (manages/tracks referrals, outside reviews, external providers)
Web-based/cloud solution (vendor-hosted, software as a service)	Tasking (automated tasking, follow up)
Upgrades (regular intervals, installed automatically)	Travel management (manages international travel)
