KEY STEPS FOR TRAVELLING & TRANSITING TO/VIA THE UK

It is the responsibility of all passengers to check and understand the current UK Government requirements as it applies to them. More information can be found on the gov.uk website. All passengers, with a limited number of exceptions, travelling to the UK must complete the following steps before departure:

×

All persons (including UK nationals and residents) arriving in the UK from outside the <u>common travel</u> <u>area</u> must provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test taken within 3 days of departure to the UK. Results must be in English, French or Spanish. For further information please visit: <u>gov.uk.</u>



To protect your health and others', everyone must complete an online <u>passenger locator</u> <u>form</u> before arrival in the United Kingdom. To complete the Passenger Locator Form, you need your booking reference for your testing and quarantine arrangements. You'll also need to add your flight and seat numbers.



All arrivals from a green list country are not required to quarantine on arrival. All arrivals from a amber list country must quarantine for 10 days on arrival unless exempt. If you have travelled through a <u>red list</u> <u>country</u> in the last 10 days, you must have a valid <u>managed</u> <u>quarantine facility</u> booked prior to departure. For information please visit: <u>gov.uk</u>. Check the list of <u>exempt countries</u> immediately before travel.



Everyone arriving from a green list country is required to take a coronavirus PCR test on day 2 of arrival. All arrivals from an amber and red list country must take a further coronavirus PCR test on day 8 of their quarantine. You must have this booked prior to departure. For information please visit: gov.uk.

If you quarantine in England, you may opt into Test to Release. For further information please visit: <u>gov.uk.</u>

All passengers arriving from an amber or red list country will be required to **self-isolate for 10 days** on arrival. <u>Find out more</u>. If passengers are travelling to England for less than 10 days, they will need to quarantine for the whole of their stay. They must travel directly to their place of quarantine when they arrive in England and directly from their place of quarantine to the port or airport when they leave.

INFORMATION FOR TRANSITING PASSENGERS

It is a legal requirement that customers wear a face covering on public transport in the UK.

ARRIVING / DEPARTING SAME DAY

Passengers arriving and departing from the same airport who have a boarding pass issued for onward travel do not need to pass through immigration or customs. All passengers must still complete the UK government requirements listed.

FLIGHTS ON A SEPARATE TICKET / CONNECTING DIFFERENT DAY

Passengers will be required to pass through immigration and customs in this instance. Passengers arriving from a non-red list country must self-quarantine until their next flight. Those arriving from a 'red list' country are required to present a confirmed booking at an approved UK government quarantine hotel. Hotel booking can be carried out here. DOMESTIC CONNECTIONS

Passengers transiting through Heathrow for a domestic connection from a 'red list' country must carry out their ten-day hotel quarantine at a government approved quarantine hotel in the Heathrow area.

EXCEPTIONS FOR INBOUND TRAVELLERS

Passengers may qualify for exemptions when travelling for work because of the jobs they do. The list of jobs that qualify for exemptions including testing requirements can be found on the gov.uk website here. The website lists which restrictions apply, and which do not apply for each permitted exception, as well as any conditions passengers will need to meet or evidence they will need to show.
