DEA Business Activity and its connection to DEA DATA-waiver information

The following table defines the Business Activity code-subcode combinations assigned by the DEA and presented on an AMA Profile. These combinations help to confirm those physicians in possession of a DEA DATA waiver to provide office-based opioid treatment using buprenorphine. This waiver is also referred to as an *X*-waiver and a *buprenorphine-waiver*.

C-9	Practitioner – Department of Defense Contractor – DATA waiver to provide office-based opioid treatment to 30 patients
C-A	Practitioner – Department of Defense Contractor – DATA waiver to provide office-based opioid treatment to 100 patients
C-B	Practitioner – DATA waiver to provide office-based opioid treatment to 275 patients
C-C	Practitioner – Military – DATA waiver to provide office-based opioid treatment to 275 patients
C-D	Practitioner – Department of Defense Contractor – DATA waiver to provide office-based opioid treatment to 275 patients

The DEA assigns a unique identification number (UIN) to those physicians and other clinicians approved by the Center for Substance Abuse Treatment to conduct office-based opioid treatment, i.e., DATAwaived clinicians. Within the industry, this UIN is sometimes referred to as an X-number due to the first character of the UIN being the letter *X*. After this first character, all other characters in the UIN match the clinician's DEA registration number. For example, a DATA-waived physician with a DEA registration number of FB0123454 would also have a UIN of XB0123454.
