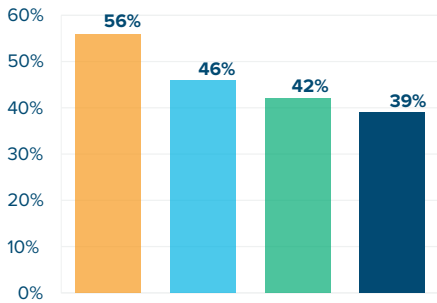


Survey finds top concern for software development leaders is wasting time.

- 5 Tracking CapEx allocation

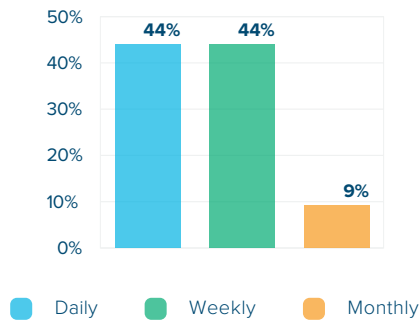
What managers worry about



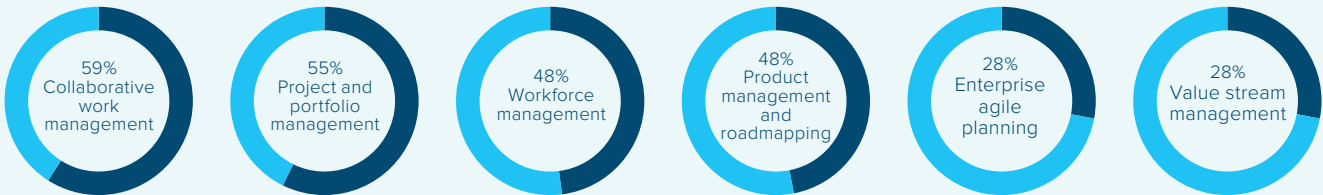
- Wasting time on mundane tasks that don't deliver value
