



Covid-19 Enhanced Cleaning

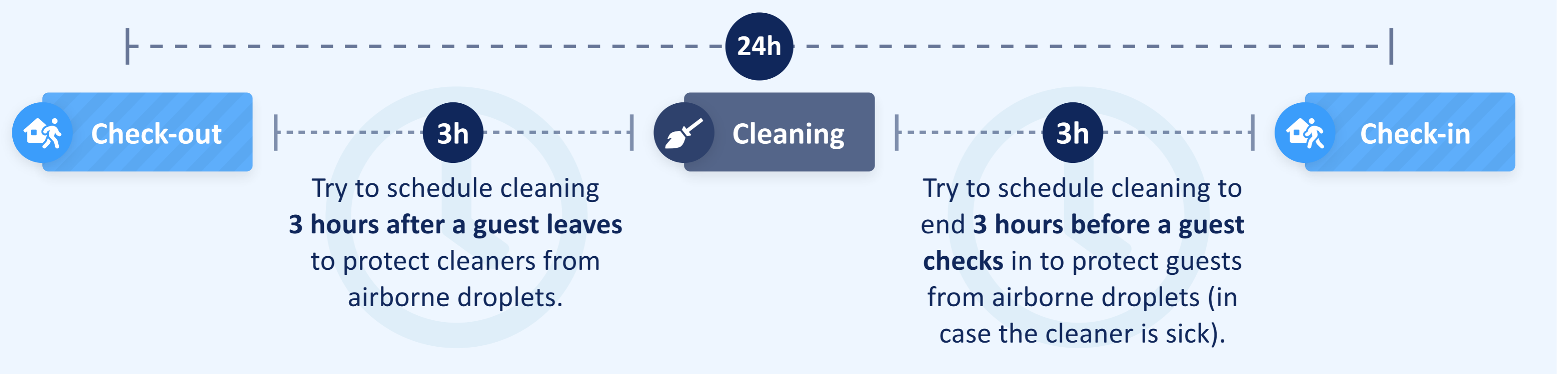
What are the risks?

Contaminated Surfaces
Transmission from surface contamination is possible.
Clean with soapy water, then disinfect with household bleach.

Airborne Droplets
It may be possible for sick guests to infect the next guest through airborne droplets.
Airborne droplets fall from the air quickly.

Value of time

Taking at least a day in between guests can resolve most safety concerns for cleaners and guests.



Materials

- Disposable cleaning gloves.
- Lysol® Bleach Spray.
- Fabric mask for cleaners.
- Lysol® Laundry Sanitizer.
- Personal hygienic amenities.
- Disposable utensils, cups and plates.

Safety

- Cleaners need to wear a mask and gloves to protect themselves and guests.
- Practice social distancing if cleaning with other people.
- Better to use off-the-shelf products than mix your own.
- Check for expiration dates on cleaning products.

The five-step process



What to focus on

- 1 Ventilation:** Ventilate before cleaning if possible.
- 2 Frequently touched surfaces:** Door knobs, light switches, railings, remotes, tablets.
- 3 Kitchen & utensils:** Move to single use disposables.
- 4 Laundry:** Wash all linens at the highest heat setting recommended by the manufacturer.
- 5 Bathrooms:** Thoroughly clean and use personal disposable amenities.
- 6 Bedrooms:** Remove decorative pillows and throws that are not washed frequently.

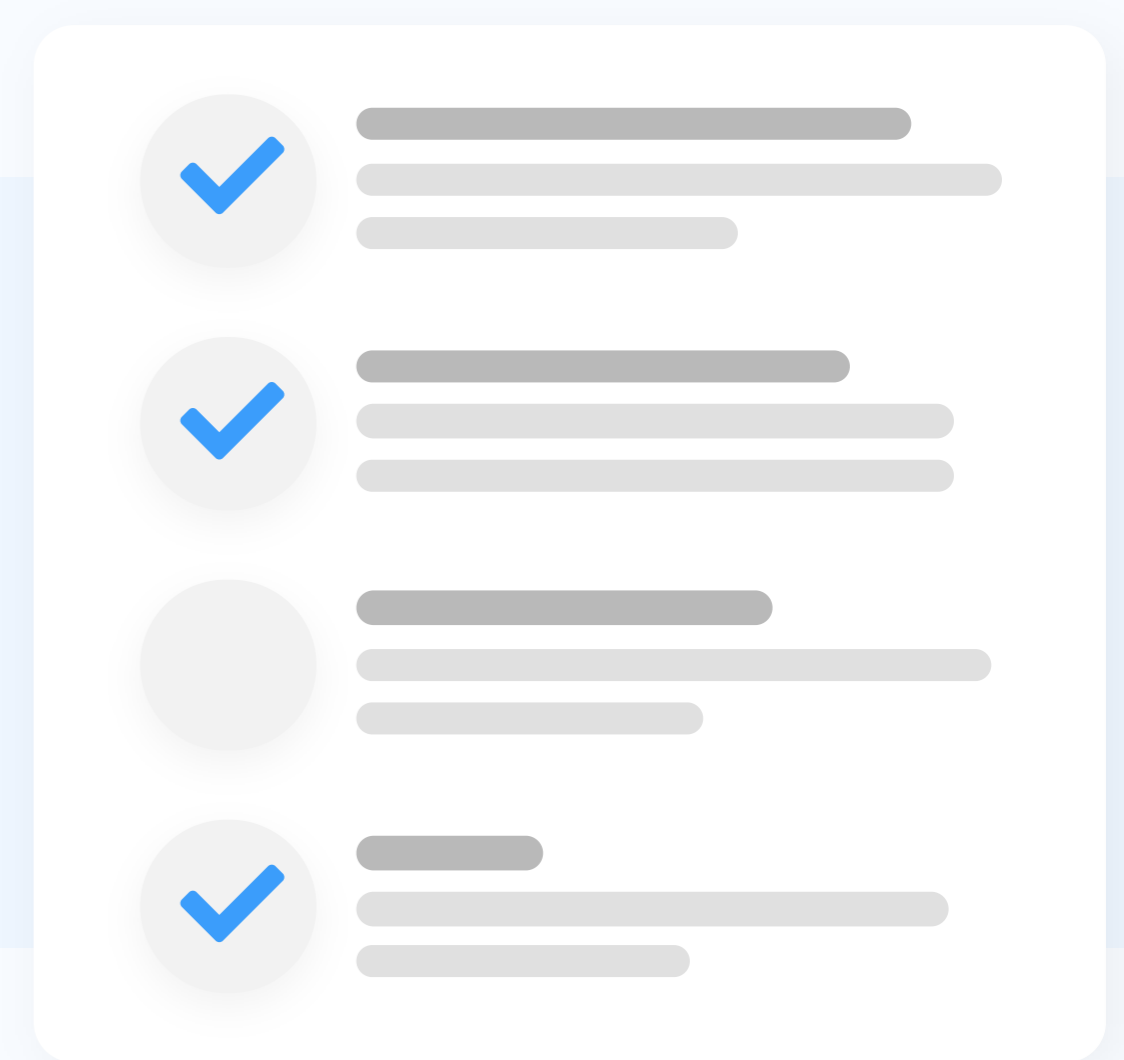
The Ultimate Checklist
