Indoor Plant Guide



In our experience, we have found the following plants to work well on our Indoor Greenwalls. The plants listed below are examples of plants we recommend for best results.

It is important when selecting plants, to ensure that you choose plants with similar watering and lighting needs. Select a combination of 4 inch or 6 inch plants to ensure a full, instant effect.

We've sorted the plants by categories:

- Base Greens: Plants that are great bases for your greenwall. They are reliable, full and lush.
- Dark Variegation: Plants with darker colors in the leaves.
- Light Variegation: Plants with lighter colors in the leaves.
- Colorful: Plants with bright colors or pops of colors.
- Texture: Plants with varied textures.

Category 1: Base Greens

Golden Pothos

Light:

Suited to medium to bright light.

Watering:

Soil should be left to dry out between watering.

Other Pothos Types: Neon, Marble Queen, Silver Splash, Green



Green Jade Pothos

Light:

Suited to medium to bright light.

Watering:

Soil should be kept moist but not wet.

Other Pothos Types: Neon, Marble Queen, Silver Splash, Golden







Philodendron Cordatum 'Heartleaf

Light:

Suited to medium to bright light.

Watering:

Soil to be kept moist.

Other Philodendron Types: Cordatum Brasil, Scandens + Mica, Split Leaf, Selloum



Dracena Compacta

Light:

Suited to low to medium light.

Watering:

Soil should be kept moderately dry.

Other Dracaena Types: Lemon Lime







Category 2: Plants with Dark Variegation

Calethea Lancifola 'Rattlesnake Plant'

Light:

Suited to medium to bright light without direct sunlight.

Watering:

Soil to be moist but not wet







Maranta Leuconeura - Prayer Plant

Light:

Suited to medium to bright light without direct sunlight.

Watering:

Soil to be moist but not wet with dry cycles.

Other Maranta Types: Leuconeura var. Erythroneura, Lemon Lime, Leuconeura 'Kerchoveana'



Maranta Lemon Lime

Light:

Suited to medium or bright light without direct sunlight

Watering:

Soil to be moist but not wet with dry cycles.

Other Maranta Types: Leuconeura var. Erythroneura, Leuconeura: 'Prayer



Calethea Burle Marx

Liaht:

Suited to medium to high light without direct sunlight.

Watering:

Soil should be moist but not wet with dry cycles.

Other Calathea Types: Lancifola: 'Rattlesnake', Ornata, Roseopicta





Category 3: Plants with Light Variegation

Pothos Silver Splash

Light:

Suited to medium or bright light.

Watering:

Soil should be kept moist but not wet.

Other Pothos Types: Neon, Marble Queen, Golden, Green Jade



Pothos Marble Queen

Light:

Suited to medium to bright light.

Watering:

Soil should be kept moist but not wet.

Other Pothos Types: Neon, Silver Splash, Golden, Green Jade





Agaonema Leprechaun

<u>Light:</u>

Suited to low to medium light without direct sunlight.

Watering:

Soil to be moist but not wet with dry cycles.

Other Algaonema Types: Pattaya Beauty, Modestum, Pink, Chinese Evergreen



Agaonema Silver Bay (Chinese Evergreen)

Light

Suited to medium to bright light.

Watering:

Soil should be kept moist but not wet.

Other Algaonema Types: Pattaya Beauty, Modestum, Pink, Leprechaun





Syngonium White Butterfly

Light:

Suited to medium to bright light.

Watering:

Soil should be left to dry between watering.









Category 4: Colorful Plants

Neon Pothos

Light:

Suited to medium or bright light.

Watering:

Soil should be kept moist but not wet with dry cycles.

Other Pothos Types: Golden, Marble Queen, Golden, Green Jade



Philodendron Cordotum Brasil

Light:

Suited to medium to bright light.

Watering:

Soil should be kept moist.

Other Philodendron Types: Heart Leaf, Scandens + Mica, Split Leaf, Selloum



Dracena Lime Light

Light:

Suited to low to medium light without direct sunlight.

Watering:

Soil to be moist but not wet with dry cycles.



Aglonema Pink

Light:

Suited to medium to bright light.

Watering:

Soil should be kept moist but not wet with dry cycles.

Other Algaonema Types: Pattaya Beauty, Modestum, Silver Bay, Leprechaun







Category 5: Plants with Texture

Spider Plant

Light:

Suited to medium to bright light without direct sunlight.

Watering:

Well drained potting soil mix



Birds Nest Fern

Light:

Suited to medium or bright light without direct sunlight.

Watering:

with dry cycles.

wave, Osaka, Antiquum, Vicotoria





Monstera- Split Leaf Philodendron

Light:

Suited to medium to bright light.

Watering:

Soil to be left to dry between watering.

Other Monstera Types: Monstera Adansonii, "Mini" Monstera Monstera Variegata



Soil to be moist but not wet

Other Asplenium Types: Crispy



Peace Lily (Spathiphyllum Wallisii)

Light:

Suited to medium to high light without direct sunlight.

Watering:

Soil should be moist but not wet.
