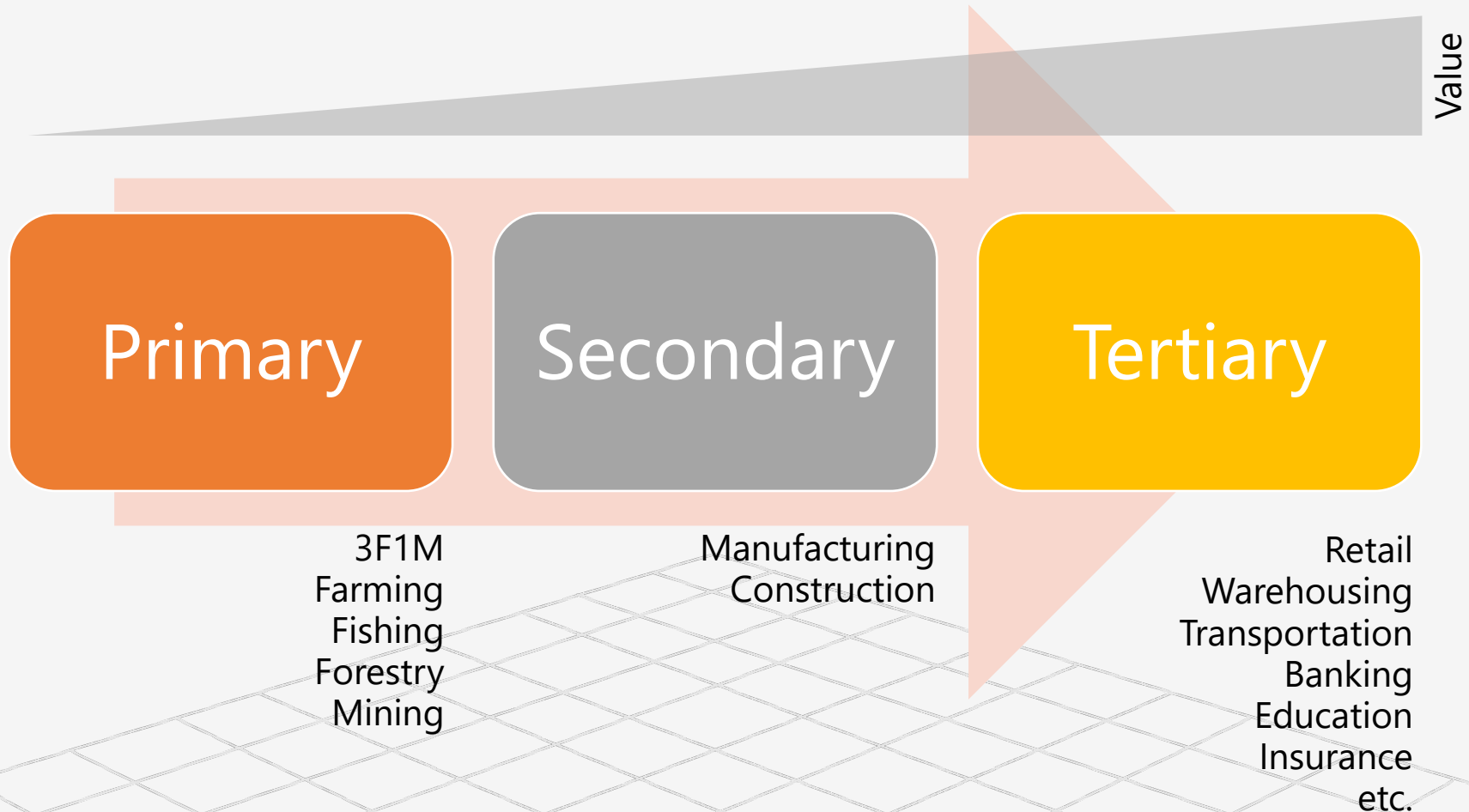
Supply chain is a network of people, processes and systems with a mission to source, store, transform and transport materials and to deliver the finished goods to the consumers.



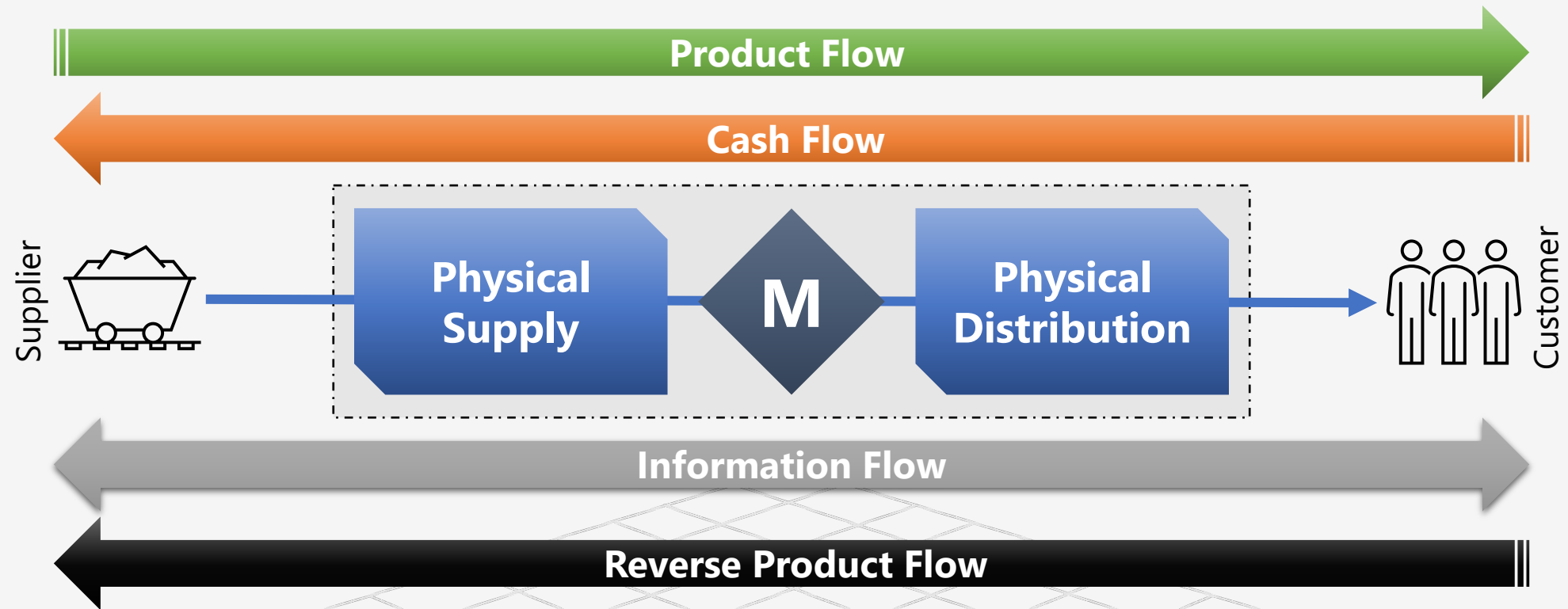
Even Pencil Needs a Global Supply Chain



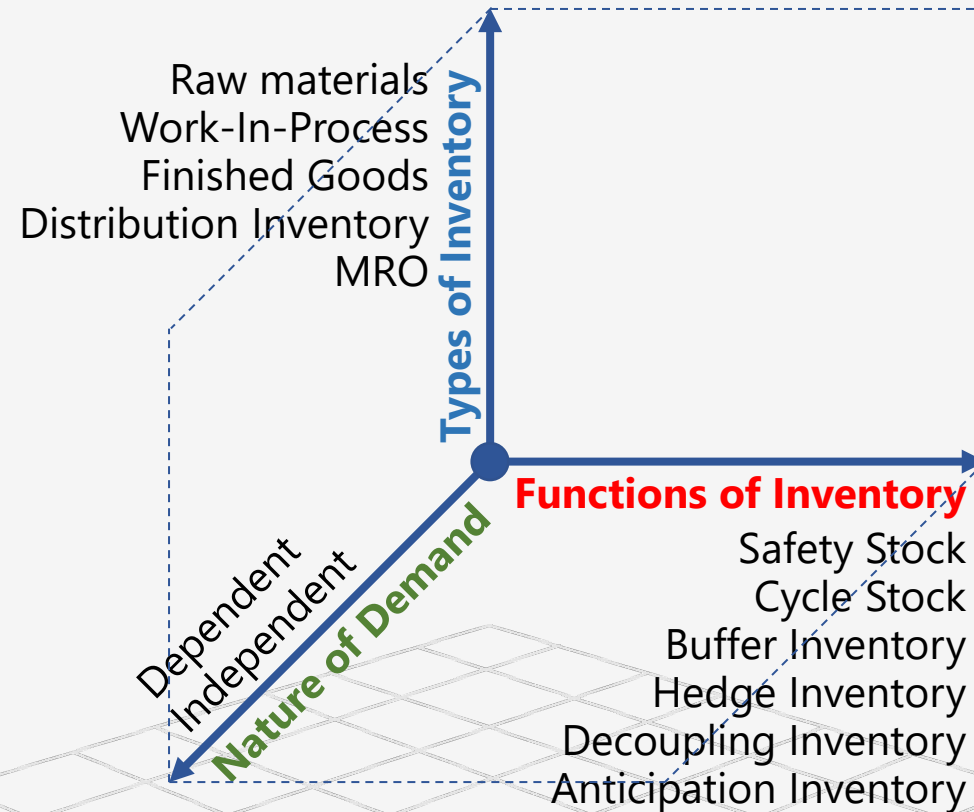

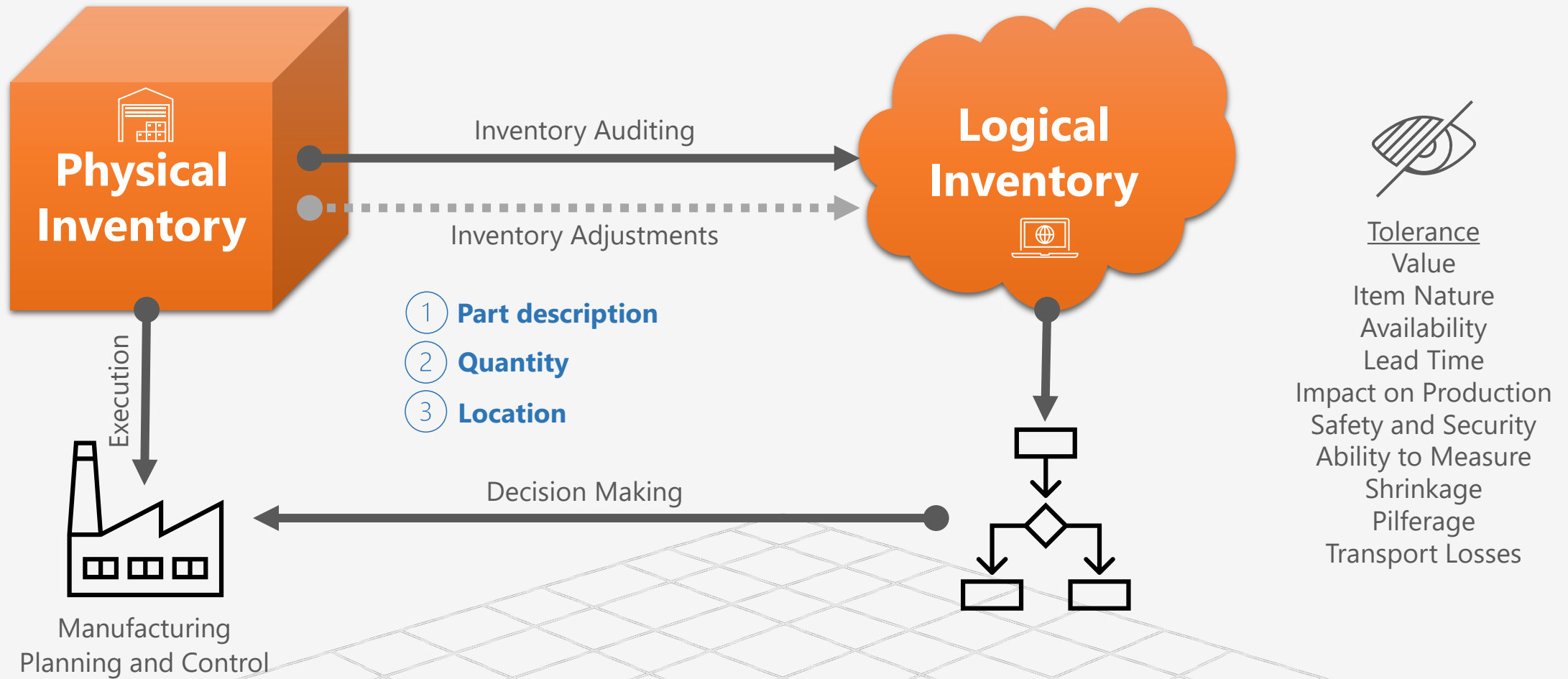
Three Entities and Four Flows
