After School Programming

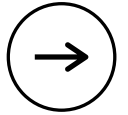
- EC - Grade 4: Care is available from 3:00 - 5:00 p.m. M-F

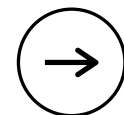
COVID Mitigation Measures

- Mask Usage
 - Mandatory indoors; outdoors socially distanced masks can be off
- Cohorts
 - We are moving away from cohorts.
 - We are exploring ways students can interact outdoors with students in other grades (Buddies, Clubs, Heron House).
- Surveillance
 - We will not use MyMedBot next school year; but will have an alternative reminder for parents to check symptoms from home.
 - Pool testing no longer required

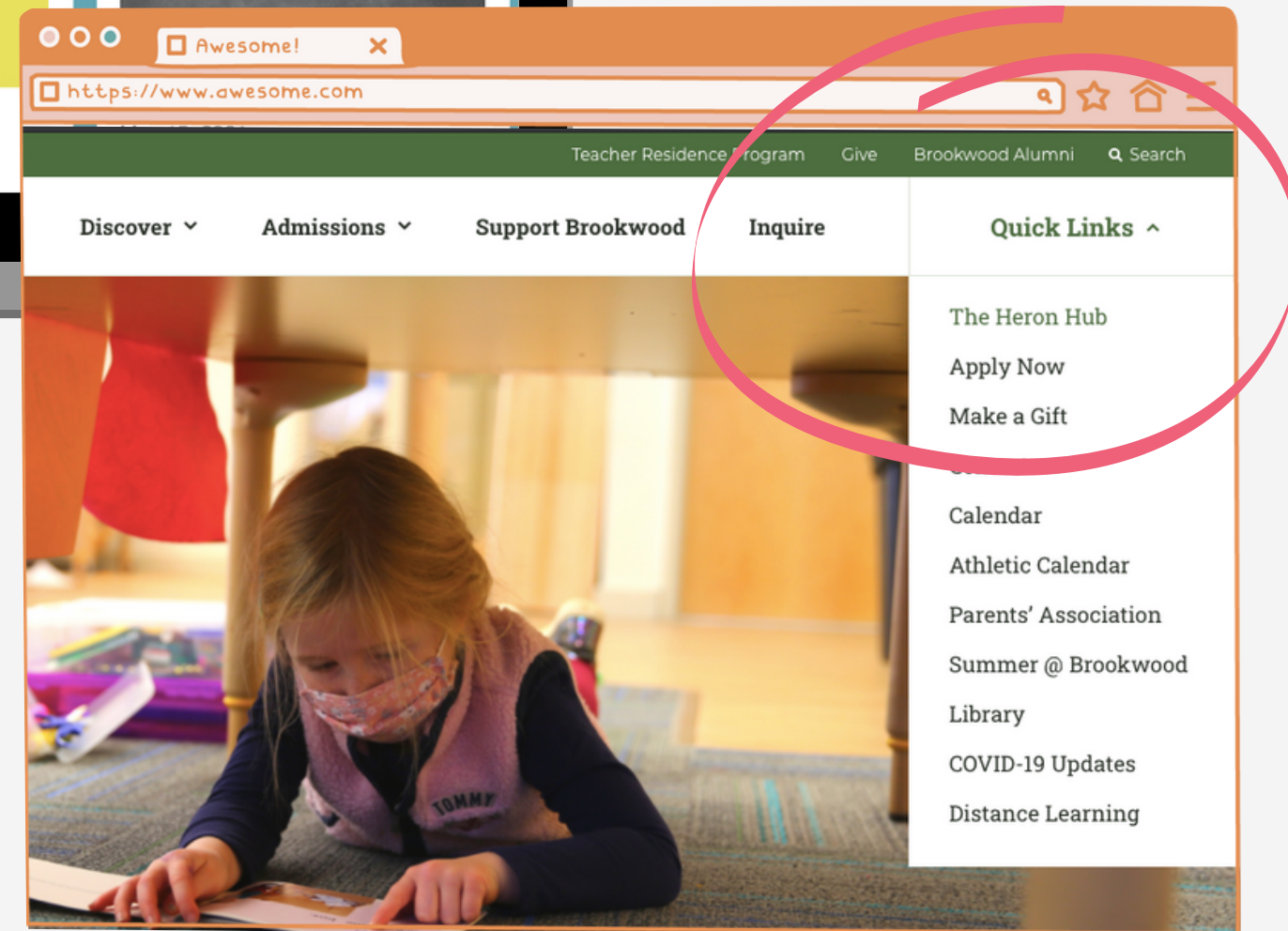
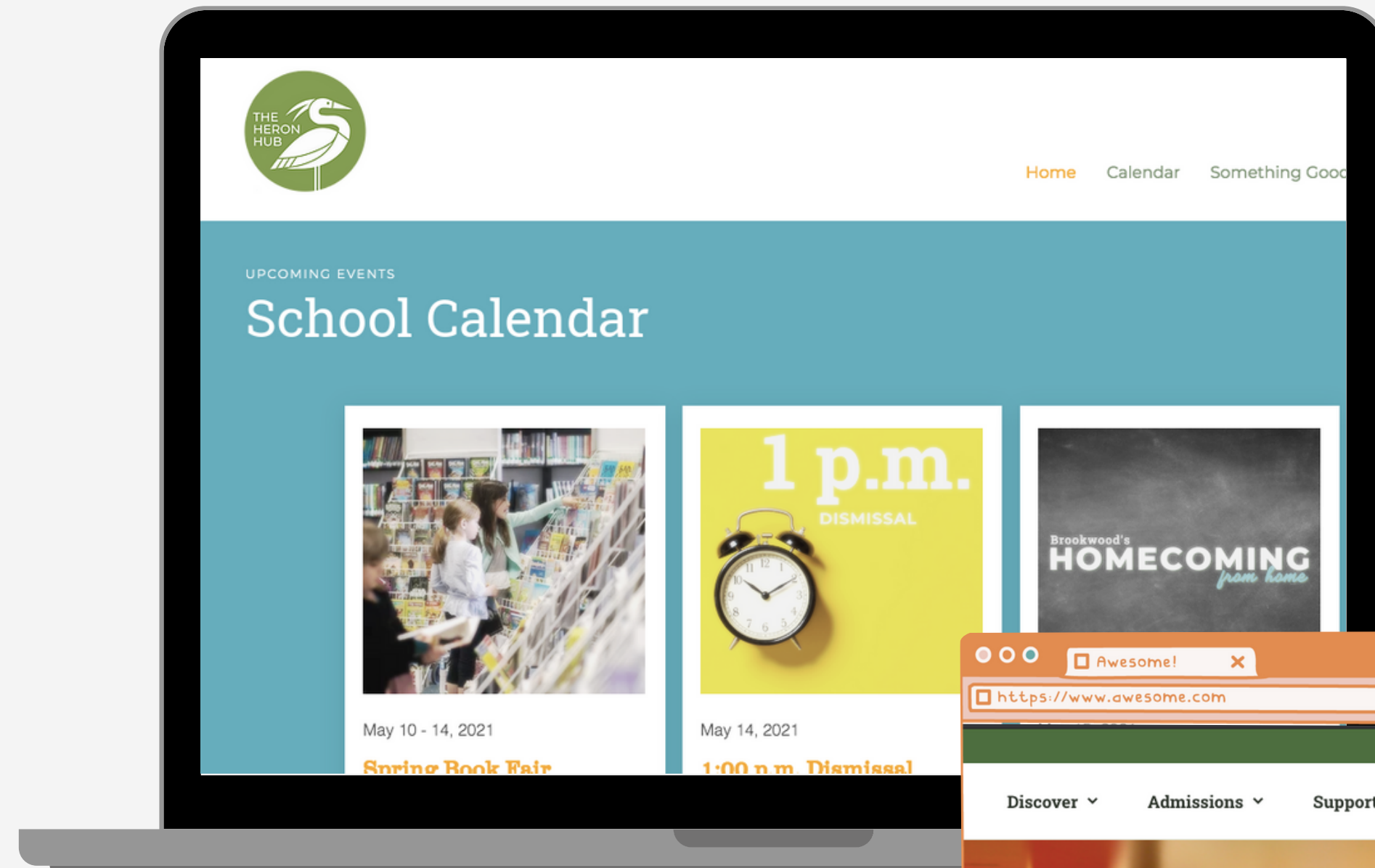

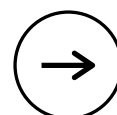
