

FAQ's

Will I get paid on my pre-apprenticeship?

Yes we'll make sure you get paid, you will receive learner incentive payments and support with travel costs.

If I have all my grades will I still need to do a pre-apprenticeship?

If you have all your grades and we feel like you are already work-ready you may not need to do our pre-apprenticeship and we can start looking for an apprenticeship position for you.

How much can I expect to earn once I get an apprenticeship?

As of April 2021, you can expect to earn a minimum of £4.30 per hour. However, some employers pay more. This averages around £650+ per month and over £8,000 per year.
