15 MONTHS DURATION
(12 months learning / 3 months EPA)

WHO IS THIS APPRENTICESHIP FOR?

This apprenticeship standard is for new entrants or those wanting to progress their career within the Supply Chain and Logistics industry.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Anyone from school leavers to career changers can enrol on this apprenticeship. As part of this standard you will need to work towards Level 2 functional skills in maths and English.

COSTS

Maximum of £3,000 if you are a Levy payer
Maximum of £150 if you are a non-Levy company



WHAT YOU'LL LEARN

This apprenticeship is delivered through a combination of planned learning sessions, workplace visits, on and off the job training and 1 to 1 support.

It covers areas such as:

- Taking deliveries and checking for damaged/missing items
- Storing and moving goods and picking and packing orders
- Loading goods for dispatch and maintaining stock records and documentation
- Safe use of a range of equipment, machinery and vehicles relevant to your role and setting

END POINT ASSESSMENT

This apprenticeship includes an end point assessment consisting of:

- Knowledge open questions and an observation

PROGRESSION OPPORTUNITIES

The skills developed in this apprenticeship could lead to employment opportunities and career progression into team leader and supervisor roles where you could enrol on to the Team Leader/Supervisor Level 3 Apprenticeship Standard.
