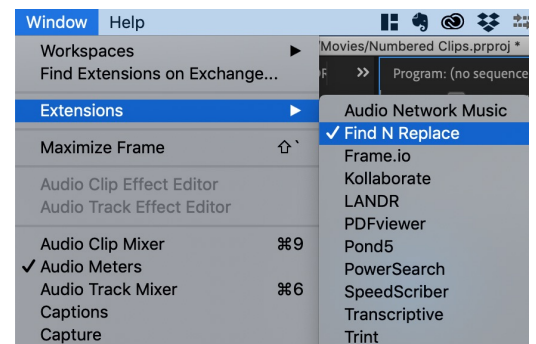

Trint's free extension for Adobe® Premiere® Pro makes it incredibly easy and faster than ever to add captions and translated subtitles. Let's walk through how with this simple six-step guide.

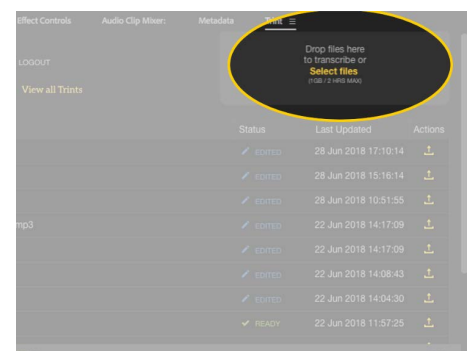
1. Get started

Log into Adobe® Premiere® Pro. Under the Windows menu at the top, select *Extension* and open the Trint panel.

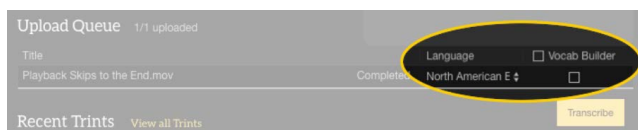


2. Upload your file

You can either *drag and drop your audio or video file* into the upload box in the upper-right corner in the Trint panel or *select files* to upload straight from your computer.



3. Add your transcription settings



Choose your transcript language and check the *'Vocab Builder'* box if you'd like to use your custom words. Hit *transcribe* when you're ready.

4. Translate your captions

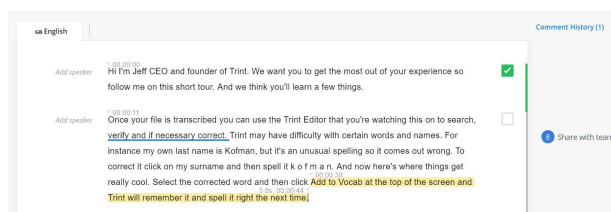

Translate your Trint into up to 54 languages and automate your translations for fast, seamless subtitles.

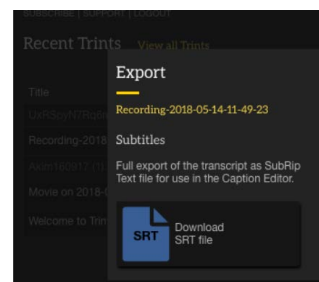
5. Verify your Trint

Launch Trint to view your transcript in the Editor - here you can edit, collaborate with colleagues and mark your Trint as verified.



6. Download your captions/subtitles

Head back to Premiere and *select the yellow 'Actions' icon* to download your file. You'll have two export formats to choose: .srt or .xml.
