Get started

Log into Trint and open *Realtime* in the left sidebar. Click *Create Realtime Trint* in the top right corner and select the *Generate stream URL* option.

Give your transcript a title and set the language and accuracy/speed. Hit *Generate Push URL*.

Copy the RTMP URL and streaming key.

Launch your Zoom meeting and under the More menu, select *Live on Custom Live Streaming Service*. Paste in the RTMP URL and streaming key. Now you're set to *Go Live*!
