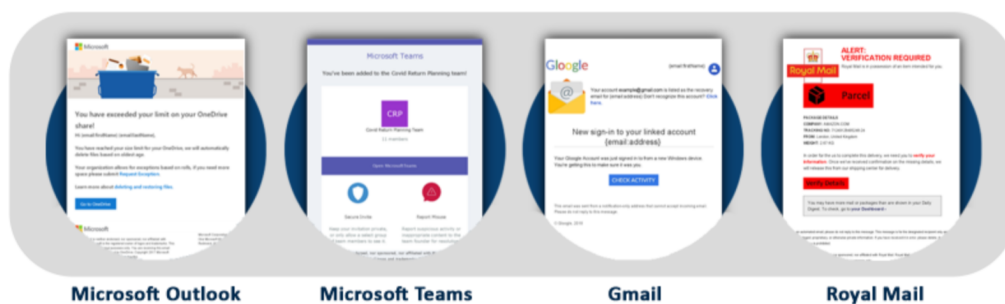


The step-by-step process
