Advanced Manufacturing

Brampton is home to Sheridan College's Centre for Advanced Manufacturing and Design Technologies and Skilled Trades Training Facility – linking companies of all sizes to Sheridan's expertise in applied research and training the future advanced manufacturing workforce.



Food & Beverage

Brampton is within close proximity to major food research centres such as the University of Guelph Food Institute, Conestoga College and the George Brown College of Food Innovation and Research Studio (FIRSt). 25 academic institutions in close proximity offering agri-food programs.



Health & Life Sciences

Home to Sheridan College of Applied Health and Community Studies. Brampton is located in North America's 3rd largest biotechnology Cluster with 100 biotechnology firms within a 30-minute drive.



Innovation & Technology

Brampton is part of the Toronto Region, North America's 2nd largest tech sector. Centrally located in the middle of The Toronto/Waterloo Innovation Super Corridor giving access to 6 million people, over 20,000 technology companies and start-ups and 30% of Canada's university students.



A Cybersecurity Ecosystem

Brampton is on the leading edge of cybersecurity and is home to the Rogers Cybersecure Catalyst, a national centre for innovation and collaboration in cybersecurity.

LABOUR FORCE

- Brampton has the 4th largest labour force in Ontario – 320,000
- Labour force is projected to grow from 332,000 to 362,000 by 2022
- 60% of the labour force in Brampton have post-secondary education

OPPORTUNITY: LABOUR SUPPLUS IN BRAMPTON

- Occupation Status in Brampton with a labour surplus
- Sales and Service Occupations – surplus of 19,500
- Business, Finance and administrative – surplus of 18,825
- Occupations in manufacturing and utilities – surplus of 11,001 Trades, transport and equipment operators and related organizations – 22,640

The catalyst provides training and certification, commercial acceleration and support for Cyber scale-ups, applied research and development, and public education. The global cybersecurity industry is expected to reach US \$2 billion by 2023. Canada had the 4th most cybersecurity venture capital deals in the world (between 2012 and 2016)

A TALENT ECOSYSTEM of the Future

Brampton has access to 20 Post-Secondary Institutions with an hours drive. More than 400,000 students are enrolled across these institutions, accounting for 75 per cent of regions overall post-secondary enrolment. Brampton is home to Sheridan College Centre for Advanced Manufacturing and Design Technologies – linking companies of all sizes to Sheridan's expertise in advanced manufacturing with the help of faculty and students.

Algoma University

Brampton Campus is located in the downtown area and offers four-year degree programs in Business, Economics and Computer Science – expanding to Psychology and a Certificate in Community Economic and Social Development.

Ryerson University

Chang School of Continuing Education offers classes in Downtown Brampton in Computer Network Security and Digital Forensics Systems.
