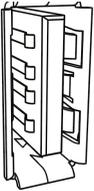

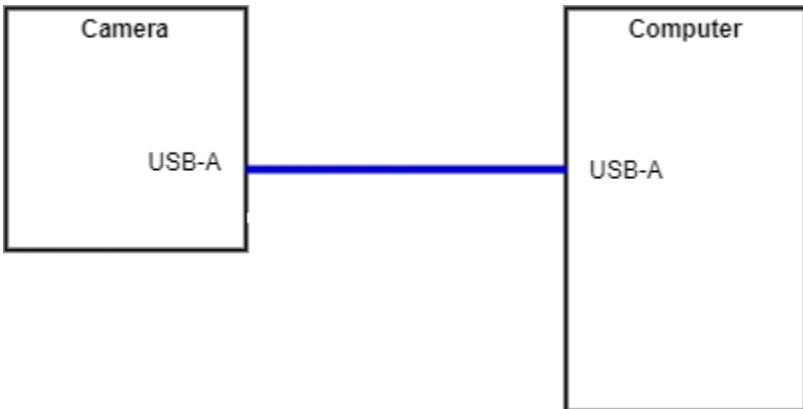
USB Connection

Your camera comes with a USB connection and a USB-A to USB-A cable. Connect one end of the included USB-A cable into the USB port of your camera. Connect the other USB-A side to a PC or to the device of your choice.



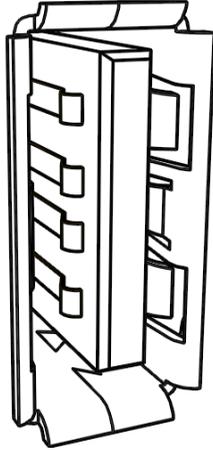
A USB-A connector
