WHAT CAUSES COVID-19 VACCINATION INEQUITY?

Are your vaccination rates **lower** for Black and Hispanic residents? Probably "yes"... but why?

Is it because they **don't want** the vaccine as much as white residents? No! According to our survey data (and others) there is very little difference in hesitancy rates. About 65% to 70%+ of Whites, Blacks, and Hispanics want the vaccine ASAP.

So why do we see significant differences in vaccination rates? Our data suggests that awareness gaps, challenges in making appointments, and inconvenient vaccination locations have had disparate impacts.

4 QUICK TIPS TO IMPROVE VACCINATION EQUITY

1. Remind people it's "FREE!"

About 15% to 20% of people don't know that the vaccine is free. Even higher for younger and poorer.

2. Remind people it's safe!

Of those who aren't vaccinated yet, uncertainty about safety is their top concern.

3. Make appointments easier!

Make sure it takes less than 5 seconds to spot your "make appointment" button on your website page(s).

4. More convenient locations!

Make vaccines available where people already go. Or, bring it to them!
