PRACTICE PSAT Test- Tuesday, January 26, 2021 9:00am-1:00pm This test will be taken at home

All 10th grade students will be taking a virtually proctored <u>practice</u> PSAT through Revolution Prep instead of attending classes. This PSAT practice exam is <u>mandatory</u> for the class of 2024. This practice exam will help students build testing endurance and give a real-time snapshot of their testing performance. The purpose of this practice test is to give students an opportunity to see what type of questions will be on the PSAT in the future. The results of this practice test will be provided to students and the school.

Due to the time constraints and administration by an outside test prep company, we are not offering extended time accommodations for this practice test. The day prior to the test, students and parents will receive an email from Revolution Prep with the necessary login information.

In order to participate, students **must** have a signed Pathfinder waiver. The waiver can be accessed <u>here</u>. Please complete the waiver no later than Wednesday, February 17, 2021. On the day of the event, parents will need to complete the Magnus form. Temperatures will be taken upon arrival at school. All of the safety protocols that we practice on a regular school day will be followed on this day.

Students are required to wear closed-toed shoes when participating in the Pathfinder program. They will be permitted to wear Tampa Prep t-shirts and athletic shorts and sweatpants. Students need to bring a water bottle with them to school that day.
